It has also been featured on *CNN*, *USA Today*, *Wired*, *NY Times*, and *NPR*. Tony's vision and creative efforts have resulted in transforming the campus into the Celebrate! Professionally, Tony has been teaching and administrating in higher education for the last 20 years. He works tirelessly to secure sponsors and raise money so he can offer this "Ted" like experience to his students and the greater community absolutely free of charge. Personally, he's been even more active helping change the face of both Des Moines and Iowa. He has served on numerous boards, including chairing the West Des Moines Chamber in 2015 and sitting on the Greater Des Moines Partnership board, and works with the West Des Moines Rotary. Somehow he has

also found time to write and publish one of his most acclaimed books, **Beware the Purple People Eaters: A Personal Look at Leadership,** which covers one of his core beliefs, "In order to effectively lead others, you have to be able to successfully lead yourself." On top of everything else, he created and oversees the largest 3 on 3 basketball tournament in Central lowa (which began in 2004). The purpose of this event is to raise money for student scholarships. To date he has raised over \$250,000.
