Among Des Moines business leaders, Justin Wise is in a class all his own. I met Justin when I interviewed him for "Three Minutes in the Chair." It's a weekly segment I used to host on Channel 13. Simply put: Justin Wise gets it. His passion for our city is obvious, whether he's helping a local business or organization or chatting with guests on his new podcast about what makes Des Moines so wonderful. And don't blink... because before you know it he will have gained more followers. Today, it's up to 41,000. Most of them aren't from around here. But because of Justin Wise, they think Des Moines must be a pretty cool place to live.
