Jeromy has over ten years of experience in managing and completing environmental services. These services include extensive project work with: National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) assessments, Phase I and II Environmental Site Assessments (ESAs), Indoor Air Quality Investigations, Asbestos & Lead Based Paint Inspections, Nationwide Programmatic Agreement reviews (NPA or PAL), Environmental Assessments (EA), Environmental Assessment Worksheets (EAW), soil vapor sampling, wetland investigations and biological assessments. Notably, Jeromy has managed and executed all aspects of environmental compliance for wireless telecommunications tower projects throughout the United States, particularly throughout the Midwest.

Jeromy has consulted on Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Brownfields and Iowa Land Recycling Program (LRP) projects throughout Iowa. Jeromy has worked closely with municipalities, state and federal regulators and citizens within the project areas in an effort to successfully implement brownfields grants or state regulations. Jeromy has overseen and participated in grant writing, community outreach initiatives, completion of Phase I & II ESAs, enrollment and management of properties through the Iowa LRP, conducting observation at demolition sites and implemented asbestos perimeter monitoring. Jeromy is responsible for managing, implementing and reporting for state and EPA assessment, cleanup and redevelopment projects throughout Iowa.

Jeromy has completed work throughout Iowa and Kansas under the Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) fund and through the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) storage tank division. Underground Storage Tank (UST) field work includes the installation and monitoring of remediation systems, bio remediation implementation, sampling of soil, vapor and groundwater, the retrieval and disposal of free product, geotechnical investigations including soil classification, and site surveying. Jeromy also had reporting responsibility for UST projects that include: Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3 reports, Site Monitoring Reports and Free Product reporting. Jeromy has assisted the state through potable water, waste water and storm water sampling in an effort to meet applicable compliance commitments. Jeromy also has assisted many private sector clients throughout the United States with Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) assessments pertaining to mold and silica. Jeromy has also managed and completed numerous biological evaluations under guidance of the Migratory Bird Act that include: nesting site evaluations, biological report evaluations and the issuance of permits for work commencement through the state Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission.
