She is a respected leader amongst her peers and serves on the Broadlawns Medical Executive Board and was designated as the physician liaison for a recent upgrade of the hospital's electronic medical record system.

As an up-and-coming thought leader in the healthcare community, Dr. Gilg Gachiani was appointed by the Governor to serve on the Iowa Board of Medicine where she has chaired two governance committees. She serves on numerous healthcare boards and lends her recommendations for ways to effectively facilitate access to healthcare and address social determinants of health. She serves as an adjunct educator for the University Of Iowa Carver College Of Medicine and at Des Moines University. As a volunteer, Dr. Gilg Gachiani practices at the Free Clinics of Iowa and recently was a caregiver physician on a climb of Mount Kilimanjaro for Above and Beyond Cancer.

Dr. Gilg Gachiani personifies all of the attributes you admire in an effective leader. She thoughtfully inserts herself into discussions and lends credible insights as to how systems and policies can improve the lives of others. She is respectful and interested in learning from others.
