Her work has received local, regional and national awards and recognitions.

Much of Kylee's community work has been done on behalf of ChildServe, where she has served on the Board of Trustees since 2013 (in her third term). She stepped up in a time of great need by helping create the first-ever Bubble Ball, and she served as the event's Co-Chair. She has been involved in growing the event ever since. As a member of the Greater Des Moines Leadership Institute Class of 2014, Kylee worked with Courage League Sports on a project that raised more than \$140,000 to enhance the group's facilities. She also has served in leadership roles for Young Variety, Art Noir, Iowa State Fair Corn Dog Kickoff, and more. Personally, I have worked alongside Kylee on the Art Route DSM Marketing Committee, Des Moines Playhouse Hollywood Halloween Committee and Delta Gamma Advisory Board. She shares her gifts of creativity and collaboration with all organizations she commits to serving.
